



**Acts of  
City Council of Hinton  
Regular Meeting  
Tuesday October, 15 2013  
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Council President Larry Meador, Councilwoman Roberta Sorg, Councilman Pat Jordan, and Councilman Bobby Basham were all present. City Manager Cris Meadows, Chief of Police Derek Snavelly, and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Lynn Maddy led the prayer and the pledge of allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan, moved to approve the minutes of the September 2013 regular city council meeting. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Basham moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report September 2013 – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the financial report September 2013. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
7. Approval of Building Permits – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the building permits. Councilman Basham seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
8. Appearance of Citizens – Lynn Maddy informed council of his positive experience at the Festival of the Rivers. Mayor Blankenship read a letter from the pastor of First Baptist Church thanking council for repairing the alley behind the church.
9. Discussion and or action regarding Brooks Sewer Project – Councilman Basham moved to approve the payment of \$312,157.01. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
10. Discussion and or action regarding Gold Coast Project – Councilman Basham moved to approve the payment of \$164,810.87. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
11. Discussion and or action hiring policeman – Chief Snavelly recommended to council that Shawn Weikle be hired as a policeman. Councilman Basham moved to hire Shawn Weikle as a policeman. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
12. Discussion and or action regarding purchase of police cameras – Chief Snavelly asked the council to purchase body worn cameras to help in investigation and recording of arresting of criminals. Councilman Meador moved to purchase two cameras, one

standard license, one basic license and 30X10 storage. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.

13. Adjournment – Councilman Basham moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
