



**Acts of
City Council of Hinton
Regular Meeting
Tuesday February, 19 2013
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Councilman Tommy Oxley, Councilman Larry Meador, and Councilman Bobby Basham were all present. City Manager Cris Meadows, Police Chief Snaveley, and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance. Councilman Pat Jordan was absent.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Lynn Maddy led the prayer and the pledge of allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Oxley moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Oxley moved to approve the minutes of the January 2013 regular city council meeting. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Meador moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Oxley seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report January 2013 – Councilman Meador moved to approve the financial report January 2013. Councilman Oxley seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
7. Appearance of Citizens – Stuart Oxley thanked the city for fixing a culvert. Brenda Wilson discussed the Blueprint Communities program and thanked the Mayor for being a part of their team. Dwight Emrich addressed council and asked for them to include funding for the 4th of July picnic at the pool.
