Regular Meeting
Tuesday August, 19 2014

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Larry Meador, Councilwoman Sorg and Councilman Bob Basham were all present. City Manager Cris Meadows and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance.
