



**Acts of
City Council of Hinton
Regular Meeting
Tuesday November, 18 2014
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Larry Meador, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were all present. City Manager Cris Meadows, Chief Pivont, Chief Snavely and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance. Councilman Basham was unable to attend.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Meador moved to approve the minutes of the October 2014 regular city council meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Meador seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report October 2014 – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the financial report October 2014. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
7. Approval of Building Permits – Councilman Meador moved to approve the building permits. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
8. Appearance of Citizens – Curtis Shaver requested reimbursement for attending the annual municipal judges training. Mayor Blankenship stated that he had written a letter to Curtis that he could go but we were not paying for it as we were sending Jackie Adkins and Curtis would be retiring at the end of the year.
9. Discussion and or action regarding Gold Coast Sewer- Mayor Blankenship stated they needed to close out the project and needed approval on paying the invoices in the amount of \$23,312.97. Councilman Meador moved to approve the payment and the adjustment of the contract amounts. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
10. Discussion and or action regarding Brooks Sewer Project – Mayor Blankenship asked for approval of the final payments on the project. Councilman Meador moved to approve the payments totaling \$50,660.68 and the budget revision. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
11. Discussion and or action regarding Freight Depot Project – Cris stated the project was under way and the contractor had submitted application for payment. Councilman

Meador moved to approve the application up to \$41,220.00. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.

12. Discussion and or action regarding grant submission – Cris stated he found a grant by the water company that was supposed to be used for a natural play area and had to have a component of water conservation. Council talked about the old Riverwalk plan and the plan involving the Bellepoint. They decided to submit both if possible to try and get one funded.

13. Adjournment – Councilman Jordan moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
