City Council of Hinton  
Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, January, 19 2016  
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that, Councilman Larry Meador Councilman Pat Jordan, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present. City Manager Cris Meadows and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the agenda. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the December Council meeting and the October Public Meeting. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Meador moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report December 2015 – Councilman Meador moved to approve the financial report December 2015. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
7. Appearance of Citizens – Pat Hanifan gave a report on Railroad Days and thanked the city for all it does to help with the festival. She said next year will be the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary and they hoped to be doing something special.
8. Discussion and or action regarding the Hazard Mitigation plan- Cris stated it was time to update our hazard mitigation plan and Region One was going to help us with that. He said we need to pass the enclosed memorandum. Council discussed that the last plan they needed to build the hospital access road and it was now completed. They discussed the need for a good evacuation plan for the high school in case of a train derailment. Councilman Meador moved to approve the memorandum. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
9. Discussion and or action regarding Comprehensive plan – Mayor Blankenship asked council to review the plan and ask Anna Zeigler to come to the next meeting and go over it with them.
