Regular Meeting
Tuesday, April 18, 2018
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Larry Meador, Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Jack Scott and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – City Manager Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda noting that items 9,10,13, &14 are being removed. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
