



**Acts of  
City Council of Hinton  
Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, December 17, 2019  
11:00 a.m. -- Hinton Freight Depot**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Jack Scott, Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Larry Meador, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and pledge.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Scott made a motion to approve both the minutes from the regular November meeting. Councilman Meador seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of financial report – Councilman Meador moved to approve the November 2019 financial report. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
7. The Appearance of Citizens – Pat Hanifan gave a report on Railroad Days they had another successful year. They are trying to do 4 days in a row next year and will probably be the week after Bridge Day. Dorothey Jean Boley thanked Mayor and Council for appointing her the Spirit of Hinton and told them how much she enjoyed the entire experience.
8. Approval of resolution for CSO grant submission – Cris presented a resolution for resubmission of the grant for the Combined Sewer overflow in Bellepoint. Councilman Meador moved to dispense with the reading and approve the resolution. Councilman Scott Seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
9. Discussion and or action regarding the Hardwoods Building – Cris stated that winter would be here soon and the roof still had not been addressed. Council discussed possibly selling the building or leasing it.
10. Discussion regarding resource officer – Mayor Blankenship stated he was working with the superintendant about partnering on a resources officer for the middle school.
11. Councilwoman Sorg moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
