Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, July 17, 2018

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Jack Scott and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present. Councilman Meador was present by teleconference.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – City Manager Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the agenda. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the June Regular Council Meeting. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Scott moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
