



**Acts of  
City Council of Hinton  
Regular Meeting  
Tuesday, May 16, 2017  
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Council President Larry Meador, Councilman Jack Scott, Councilman Pat Jordan, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – City Manager Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the April Regular Council Meeting. Councilman Meador seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report April 2017 – Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the financial report April 2017. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
7. Appearance of Citizens – None
8. Discussion and or action regarding freight depot- Council discussed cleaning at the freight depot and who's responsible for it. Cris stated this has been a problem for years and he would like to have a custodian who's responsible cleaning and maintaining for not just the depot but all city buildings. Council asked Cris and Mayor Blankenship to revisit this.
9. Discussion and or action regarding a resolution for HUD. – Cris stated council needed to approve this resolution for HUD as it is a source for funding and Region one prepared this for us to stay current with our funding sources. Councilman Meador moved to approve the resolution as presented. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
10. Discussion and or action regarding Resolution for National Parks Funding – Council discussed a resolution in support of full federal funding for our national parks to be sent to our congressional delegation. Councilman Meador moved to approve the resolution. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion and the motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
11. Discussion regarding vicious dogs - Council discussed a need for an ordinance relating to the banning of pit bull breeds of dogs. Garry Wheeler, the dog warden, stated he has had many instances of these dogs being problems and the latest was an officer being attacked during an arrest just last week. Richard Gunnoe stated he had some similar ordinances that other cities have used and he can draft something for the next meeting for further discussion.
12. Councilwoman Sorg moved to adjourn the meeting. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
