City Council of Hinton
Regular Meeting
Tuesday, May 19, 2020
7:00 p.m. – ZOOM Web Meeting**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the Zoom meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Jack Scott, Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Larry Meador, and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – Cris Meadows led the prayer and pledge.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilman Meador moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular April meeting. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilwoman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilman Meador seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
6. Approval of financial report – Councilman Meador moved to approve the April 2020 financial report. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4-0.
7. Approval of Budget Revision – Cris explained the needed changes in the budget as some categories he had collected more money that was anticipated and he was distributing it back into the budget as shown. Councilman Scott moved to approve the revision as presented. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.

Discussion and or action regarding changes to employee medical leave policy – Mayor Blankenship stated that due to the new COVID regulations he felt it necessary to modify the employe medical leave policy to reflect changes in affect by the Division of Labor. Councilman Meador and Attorney Gunnoe agreed. Councilwoman Sorg moved to adopt the changes to the employee medical leave policy.
