



**Acts of
City Council of Hinton
Regular Meeting
Tuesday, October 17, 2017
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. Call to order/Roll Call – Mayor Joe Blankenship called the meeting to order, and the record showed that Councilman Pat Jordan, Councilman Jack Scott and Councilwoman Roberta Sorg were present. Councilman Meador was absent.
2. Invocation / Pledge of Allegiance – City Manager Cris Meadows led the prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Approval of Agenda – Councilwoman Sorg moved to approve the agenda. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion, and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
4. Approval of Minutes- Councilman Jordan moved to approve the minutes of the September Regular Council Meeting. Councilman Scott seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.
5. Approval of Paid Invoices – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the paid invoices. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.
6. Approval of Financial Report September 2017 – Councilman Jordan moved to approve the financial report September 2017. Councilwoman Sorg seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 3-0.
7. Appearance of Citizens – none appeared
8. Discussion and or action regarding hiring a police officer – Chief Snavelly recommended rehiring Howard Lemon who had just left us recently. Councilman Jordan moved to rehire Howard Lemon as a policeman. Councilman Scott seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.

Discussion and or action regarding master plan – Council discussed the master plan for the depot district and agreed with Cris to file a grant application for the Hardwoods building to fix the major roof issues, repoint the brick and restore the windows. They also wished to pursue the parking lot for the passenger depot.
