Regular Meeting  
Tuesday December 21, 2010  
7:00 p.m. -- Hinton City Hall**

1. **Call to order / Roll Call** - Mayor Blankenship called the meeting to order and the record showed that Councilman Jordan, Councilman Oxley came in late; Councilman Meador and Councilman Basham were all present. City Manager Cris Meadows, Chief of Police Derek Snavelly, Fire Chief Ray Pivont and City Attorney Richard Gunnoe were also in attendance.
2. **Invocation / Pledge of allegiance** - Len Maddy led the devotions and the pledge of allegiance.
3. **Approval of Agenda** - Mayor Blankenship asked for approval of the agenda Councilman Basham made a motion to approve the agenda. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
4. **Approval of Minutes November 16, 2010** - Councilman Jordan moved to approve the November 16, 2010 minutes. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
5. **Approval of November 2010 paid invoices** - Councilman Jordan moved to approve the November 2010 paid invoices. Councilman Meador seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
6. **Approval of November 2010 financial report** - Councilman Jordan moved to approve the financial report. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
7. **Approval of Unpaid Invoices** - Councilman Meador moved to approve the unpaid invoices. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
8. **Approval of building permits** - Councilman Jordan moved to approve the building permits. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.

10. **Discussion and or action concerning Railroad Days Committee** – Pat Hannifin appeared before council and thanked them for their support of the festival and presented them with a financial report from the festival and a certificate of appreciation.
11. **Discussion and or action concerning Gold Coast Sewer Project** – Councilman Meador moved to approve the payment request on the Goldcoast Project. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0. Councilman Meador moved to approve requisition ten for the Gold Coast project. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 3-0.
12. **Discussion and or action concerning Brooks Barksdale Project** – Councilman Meador moved to approve the resolution to allow the Mayor to sign the paperwork for the Brooks sewer project. Councilman Jordan seconded the motion. Councilman Basham asked to amend to motion to include Councilman Meador as a signer on the documents. The motion passed on a vote of 3-0. Councilman Meador moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel. Councilman Basham seconded the motion and the motion passed 3-0. Mayor Blankenship called the meeting back to order and stated no decision had been made.
13. **Discussion and or action concerning police K9 unit** – Mayor Blankenship stated the K9 officer Sergeant Lucas would be leaving the department to further his career as a State Trooper and we would no longer be using the canine unit. Councilman Meador moved to accept sealed bids for sale of the K9 “Rex” till the next council meeting and the council would reserve the right to accept or reject any or all bids. Councilman Oxley seconded the motion and the motion passed on a vote of 4-0.
